












A Sit Down With Our New and Not-So-New City and County Judges

I try to let them know what they will be doing and when we will have scheduled breaks. It is very important to treat the jurors with respect and try to make their time with us a good experience.

As a group, is there anything lawyers could do to help judges?

Bringing a courtesy copy of any pleadings, exhibits or documents at issue for the court.

What would you like people to know about you?

One of the things that has helped prepare me for serving as a trial judge is my experience as a practicing lawyer. I know what it is like to try to be in two places at the same time, having to deal with difficult clients and the day-to-day pressure of the practice of law.
